COVID-19 Vaccinations

After an extraordinary year when all of us have all been affected by Coronavirus, we are delighted to be part of the amazing, national roll out of Covid vaccinations.

We have been running vaccination clinics from College Way Medical Centre as well as at Crown, with other patients going to Taunton Racecourse for their jab. We are grateful for the positive feedback we've had from patients attending the clinics. We were also proud to discover that Somerset has provided more first vaccinations than any other county in England: 96.3% of all over 80s and 93.4% of all over 70s (figures correct at 12 February.)

Our most vulnerable patients are being called for their vaccines first, and we are busy calling our other patients. We will make sure everyone is called when it's their turn. This is a massive operation with staff working overtime to make the operation run smoothly. You can play your part by not calling us to find out when you will be getting your vaccination, please be assured we will contact you in due course. We will soon be using a new system called Accubook where patients will be sent a text to their mobile phone with a link to allow them to book their own appointment; this will help speed up the process. So, it would be good if you can make sure we have an up to date mobile number.

We thank all patients for being very understanding and patient with the surgery during this difficult time.

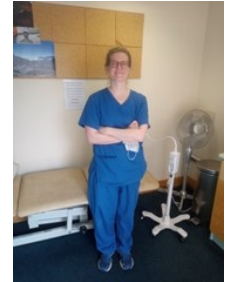
We are recruiting salaried GPs to replace Drs Huntley and McElroy.

Admin Team:

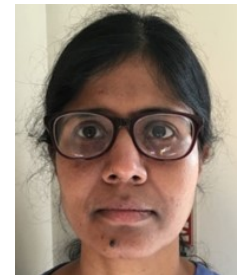

Online Prescription Requests

We are happy to receive your prescription request by phone or in writing, but it's much quicker and easier to use one of the online methods which are available at any time. You can email us at somccg.prescriptions.crownmc@nhs.net or we can help you to set up a log in to Patient Access.

You can also request repeat prescriptions through the NHS App and through any of the online pharmacies available.

Online Consultations

You may find our E-Consult facility useful if you have a non-urgent health problem. You can access this via our home page or we can text you a link with some instructions. E-Consultations allow you to access a wealth of health advice, self-care tips and information any time of the day or night or to contact your doctor directly with a health query. Please don't hesitate to get in touch with us if you are struggling with a new or existing health problem.

All first appointments are by phone, but please be assured that your doctor will arrange a face to face appointment if this is needed. This system has proved to be clinically safe and effective and much more convenient for patients.



We are now able to send and receive text messages and photos from patients, so please make sure you let us know if you change your mobile phone number.

Patient Participation Group (PPG)

The patient led, Patient Participation Group (PPG) has, for obvious reasons not met since the start of the pandemic but meetings will be resumed as soon as it is safe to do so.

As recommended by NHS England, it is likely that meetings will be virtual meetings for the foreseeable future.

The group enables us to obtain feedback on a number of issues including the range and quality of services provided by the practice. We need to ensure that the group is a representative sample of our practice population and would welcome expressions of interest from other patients.

New Telephone System

On Tuesday 23rd March, we changed our telephone system. There are few important things to note. Going forward if you telephone the surgery you should not longer receive an engaged tone. Your call will be placed in a queue for our reception team. If the queue is quite large you are able to ask for a call back and the telephone system will automatically hold your place in the queue. It will then ring you back when you move down the queue to call position 2. If you need to order or discuss any medications during the prescription desk opening hours, you can now press option 2 and you will be automatically placed in the prescription desk queue.

You will also notice the options have changed, these are as follows;

- Appointments and results — Select option 1
- Prescriptions (to order and discuss any medication queries) — Select option 2
- Secretaries (to discuss referrals and medical reports) — Select option 3
- General reception queries — Select 4
- Coronavirus admin enquires — Select 5

We ask that you are patient with our reception team whilst they are finding their feet in using the system and we apologise if it takes us a little longer to answer you call whilst we adjust to the changes.
